Reference is made to our receipt of your correspondence dated July 4, and to correspondence dated July 5, which was addressed to the FBI, Washington, D.C. It has been forwarded to the FBI's Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Division for response, in regard to Mr. Harmon Lyn Wilfred's request for a copy of his FBI identification record.

Without a notarized authorization to release information to you, we are only able to respond in general terms.

Based on *Doyle v. United States Department of Justice* 494 F. Supp. 842 (1980), the FBI's CJIS Division denies requests from individuals for copies of records, if a record search reveals an arrest with an active want, and the subject provides a foreign address for return of documents.

Only upon resolution of the warrant, will records be released. Mr. Wilfred has been directed to the wanting agency for resolution. Only the agency which entered the want can remove it from the National Crime Information Center and authorize its removal from the FBI identification record. For further assistance, Mr. Wilfred must contact the El Paso County Sheriff's Office.
