
Dear Alan & Karen,

With respect to the diplomatic protest and intent to file a civil suit against the US Federal Government, these are actions that I would prefer not to take. The federal prosecutor already knows they are vulnerable to these actions or they would not have already had a federal judge seal the records on the recent "dismissed" charges against me. I cannot believe that they want an international incident on the record as a result of my filing these actions. On the contrary, in lieu of filing such actions, it is my intent to make peace with them by requesting a meeting at the Federal level to discuss the real cause of this mess. The Feds were brought into this case by the State of Colorado and put in a position to violate the International Treaty, all because of the State vendetta against me involving the El Paso County Pension Fund issues / John Suthers et al. I have been asking my previous attorneys to approach the Federal Prosecutor for an investigation on this issue for over two years to no avail. The advice of these attorneys and the "Republican" power structure in Colorado is "**If you go to the Federal Prosecutor on these issues you will never see your children again**".

Maybe now that the the Feds have been "taken in" by the State of Colorado to the extent of violating international law, and in lieu of filing a diplomatic complaint, they would be willing to listen. This is what I would like to discuss with you with respect to opening up communication with the US Department of Justice in Washington DC, perhaps through Gregory Craig. This is a mission of peace and diplomacy with the Feds, not war. To combine forces to take out the real perpetrator. To point out the real source of the problem and unite with them to eliminate the real problem once and for all.

I believe it is clear that my greatest and most immediate vulnerability at this time comes from the issues relating to the Federal charges recently filed and dismissed. Would you please assist me to get direct communication with the US Department of Justice to discuss the above strategy. I will be contacting your office today to set a meeting for further discussion on this matter.
