We advise that we continue to act for Mr Wilfred in the above matter.

We refer you to the attached notice from Child Support Services dated 19 October 2005 and received at our office on 31 October 2005. For clarity, the following is a schedule of progress towards complying with your requests for an update on Mr Wilfred's financial status and subsequent adjustment to his child support requirements:

- 7 July 2005 - Forwarded all requested information to your attention including a financial affidavit and forms required for applied adjustment to child support.
- 27 July 2005 - Received approval for adjustment from your office subject to Court approval by stipulation. The Court stipulation was enclosed with all appropriate documents to be returned for Court approval.
- 24 August 2005 - Court stipulation and accompanying documents were delivered by courier to your office for Court processing.

- 31 October 2005 - The above referenced unsigned and poorly addressed notice was received by this office (see attached) from Anne Muzzipapa, stating that,

"...based upon the financial information you provided, and your US citizenship being renounced of your accord, this office cannot complete the review and the modification on this case."

This last notice makes no sense with respect to the process that we have all been so diligent to complete, and considering our collective good faith progress to date. As this notice also directs us back to our 'Case Worker', it would seem appropriate to request a further explanation as to the meaning of this notice from your office. I look forward to your reply.
