## ORDER

This matter is before the court on the "Motion to Dismiss Including Recitation of Authorities" filed by Defendants 3M-Greco, Ltd., Houlihan-Parnes, Realtors, Goldberg Property Associates, Inc., and Mark A. Goldberg. I agree with the assertions made by defendants in their motion to dismiss. I further agree that the complaint violates rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. I decline, however, to protract this litigation even more by inviting affidavits, counter-affidavits, and a separate side-show on the question of attorney fees. The overall interest of justice will be adequately served if, as a sanction for violating rule 11, Mr. Wilfred is enjoined from filing further actions against these defendants unless and until he does so through a licensed attorney. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The motion to dismiss is granted, and the complaint is hereby dismissed.
- Plaintiff Harmon L. Wilfred is hereby enjoined from filing any further legal action against the defendants named at the beginning of this Order unless and until he retains a licensed attorney to represent him in the action.
  - In all other respects, defendants' request for relief is denied.
