ORDER

This matter is before the court on the "Motion to Dismiss Including Recitation of Authorities" filed by Defendants 3M-Greco, Ltd., Houlihan-Parnes, Realtors, Goldberg Property Associates, Inc., and Mark A. Goldberg. I agree with the assertions made by defendants in their motion to dismiss. I further agree that the complaint violates rule 11 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. I decline, however, to protract this litigation even more by inviting affidavits, counter-affidavits, and a separate side-show on the question of attorney fees. The overall interest of justice will be adequately served if, as a sanction for violating rule 11, Mr. Wilfred is enjoined from filing further actions against these defendants unless and until he does so through a licensed attorney. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED as follows:

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
1. The motion to dismiss is granted, and the complaint is hereby dismissed.

2. Plaintiff Harmon L. Wilfred is hereby enjoined from filing any further legal action against the defendants named at the beginning of this Order unless and until he retains a licensed attorney to represent him in the action.

3. In all other respects, defendants' request for relief is denied.
